

Dr. Kalyani Sarap SMS (AHDS) conducted a technical session on Azolla Cultivation, its benefits and procedure for application. She also explained about the importance of Azolla powder.

In this training programme technical input of 2 kg Azolla Mother Culture was distributed to the 13 farmers from village Kati Birsola cluster of Gondia Tahsil under On farm trial (OFT) "Assessment on Utilisation of Azolla powder on growth performance of Poultry Birds"

Later towards the end of the training program, Methods Demonstration of Azolla Cultivation was also done at Demo unit of KVK. Total 25 trainees were present.

TRAINING PROGRAMMES UNDER RKVY PROJECT

Under RKVY project i.e. Demonstration on Red Rice Variety PDKV Sakoli-RR-1, A training programme was conducted on topic "Integrated Management of Stem borer and Plant Hopper in Paddy" on dated 15.9.2022 at village Kati Tal. Gondia.

Under this projects inputs viz. Biopesticides and trichocards was distributed to the beneficiaries of RKVY demonstrations.

explained about essential fodder crops for silage making, planning for silage making, Methods of Silage, filling, compacting and covering the silo, it's cost and benefits of silage making. She also made awareness among farmers regarding (LSD) Lumpy Skin disease and it's prevention measures. Total 38 trainees were present for this programme.

A field visit was undertaken by team of scientists including Dr Syed Shakir Ali Senior Scientist and Head, Mr Manoj Bhomte SMS (Agro), Mr R D Chavan SMS (Ento) and Mr. V K Kore SMS (Horti) at village Vadegaon, Banathar and nearby villages of Gondia Tahsil to Cluster Frontline Demonstrations (CFLD's) on Pulses in which Redgram variety PDKV Tara was demonstrated on Farmers field, while under RKVY Demo Paddy variety PDKV Sakoli RR - 1(Red Rice) plots was undertaken. It was observed that both the crops are healthy as compared to control plot. The infestation of Pest is below ETL.



In addition to this Diagnostic visit was also done in Okra, flood affected paddy and other crops. Various pest and diseases were observed and accordingly recommendations was given to the farmers for getting more yield.
